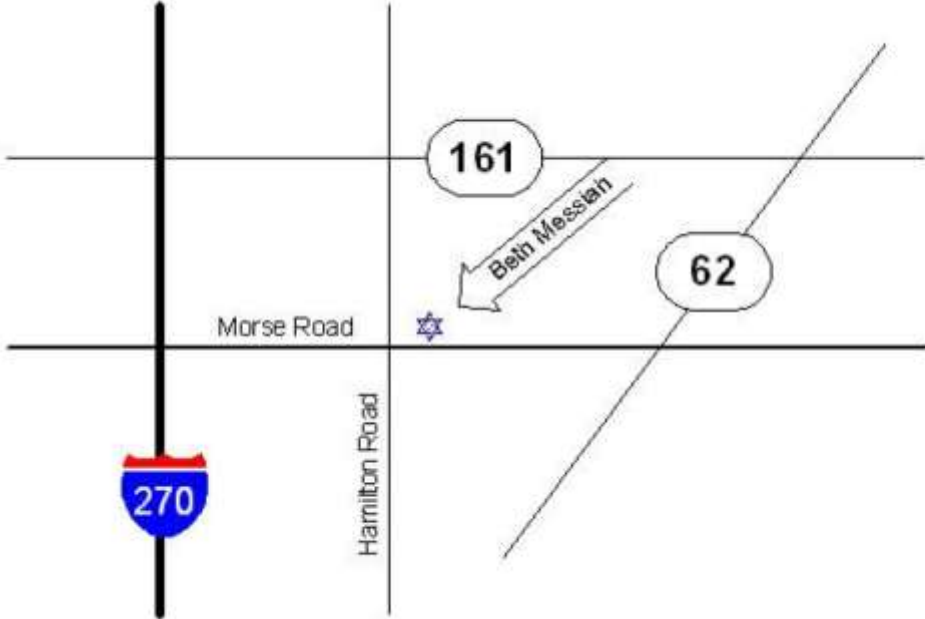
October is fast approaching, so please get your applications in for CK-120 participants! A copy of the application form is attached to the end of this newsletter.
