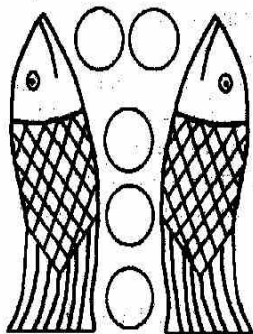

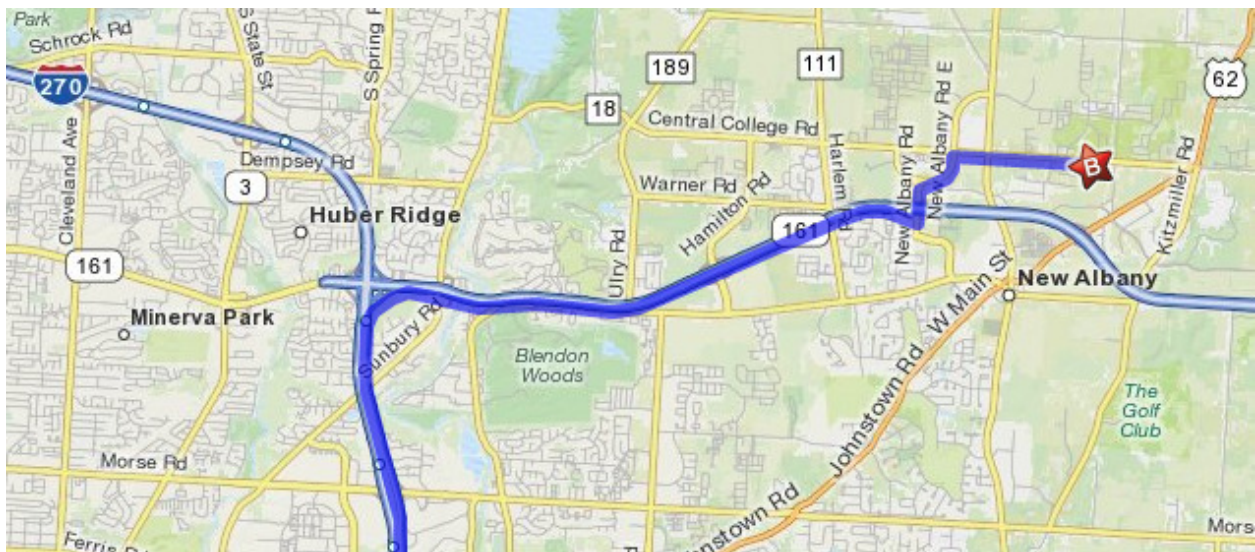
MARK YOUR CALENDARS FOR 2010 FAMILY CAMP!!
