## **Directions to Koinonia February 2009 Reunion at:**

**Franklin United Brethren Church  
7171 Central College Rd.  
New Albany, Ohio 43054**

From the east/Licking County: take 161 to the 62 N. Johnstown exit, go north about 1.5 miles, turn left on Central College Rd. (very hard to see the road, on corner with Zero's Pizza). Church is 1 mile on left.

From the west/or Columbus. Take 270 to the 161 east direction. Get off at New Albany Rd. turn left top of ramp, then immediately bend right with New Albany Rd. East. stay on this road until you get to Central College (traffic light). Turn right on Central College, church 1.5 miles down the road on the right.
